- Each patient is triaged by one of our qualified staff using state of the art equipment and the information is entered into our computers Electronic Health Record.
- Personnel specifically trained to assess occupational injuries and illnesses will take the patients history, vital signs, and complete a drug screen and breath alcohol test when required.

They will also order any additional test like x-ray, lab, pulmonary function or EKG if needed.





Once in the exam room, the patient will be evaluated by one of our Board Certified Physicians.



The physicians will then review any test results with the patient, listen to their concerns and answer questions.





Cares is capable of providing a variety of treatments from minor surgical procedures to bandaging and splinting.
